



Does the weight rating suit your needs?

Does it run quality bearings that are easy to source?

Does it come with a comprehensive locally backed warranty and owner's manual?

Is it designed and manufactured for Australian roads?

Does it meet Australian standards? (this is very important for insurance)

What will happen in the future; are spare parts easy to source?

Does it have quality components: tyres, winch, swing up jockey wheel, LED lights?

If you answer **NO** or **NOT SURE** to any of these - you may end up frustrated, and with issues in the future.
